We are ceasing to print a copy for each player in order to save costs.

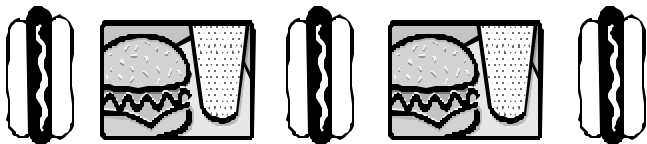
Several of last season's Kickers are already posted on the website.
