VIP OPENING DAY

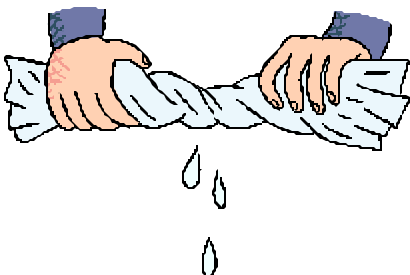
