## To Our Coaches of U8 and U6 Teams

Beginning October 8, 2005 coaches in the U8 and U6 divisions will coach from the sideline only. Up until then, one coach from each team was permitted on the field to provide instruction to their players. By week five, the children have a better understanding of the game and no longer need on-the-field directions.

Feel free to coach from the sideline in the coach's box, or "technical area", which spans the approximate length of the center circle.

### Attention Parents

Two, Four, Six, Eight, Who Do We Appreciate?

Cheering Parents! And cheering is the extent to which parents should be heard from the sidelines. Please remember that it is the coach's job to give the players directions.

More importantly, referees must always be shown the highest respect, particularly our youth referees. Whether you believe a call, or the lack of one, to be good, bad or otherwise, at **no time** is it permissible to make derogatory comments towards or about a referee. It is a tough job, we have some newly appointed referees, and **NO ONE** is perfect, so **NO ONE** will be allowed to criticize our volunteers.

## Team Referee Program

We are approaching the 1/2 mark of the season, and some teams in our U14, U12 and U10 divisions are behind in the referee assignments they must complete in order to be eligible for the tournament at the end of the season.

Next week the mailboxes will have a reminder list of the criteria that must be met to qualify. This is a team responsibility. We are only as good as the force of volunteers we have willing to help.

### Game Cards

All teams are required to complete, and make available to the referee, a game card for their game each week, including U8 and U6 teams. If you are unsure how to properly complete the game card, a sample is in the coach's handbook, or you may come to the white tent for any questions.

Likewise, referees must turn in the game cards for the games they officiated in order for the Region to properly and successfully maintain our records, including the standings for our competitive divisions. Please check your bags for any cards you may have from prior weeks, as we are missing some.
