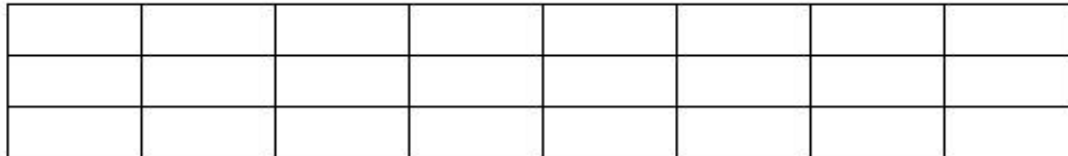

Team Referee Point Requirements Update

Please note changes to the Points Awarded section...

1. Teams must full fill their referee assignments
2. Teams must meet the minimum point requirement for their division
 - a. U14 Boys and Girls = 36 minimum points required
 - b. U12 Boys and Girls = 36 minimum points required
 - c. U10 Boys and Girls = 39 minimum points required

**Failure to meet criteria one and two will result in forfeit of team's participation in regional playoffs regardless of wins or loss
3. Divisions U10, U12, and U14, if not assigned enough games to meet minimum point requirement for their division, they can sign up for "open" games at least one week in advance. They can also referee any U8 or U6 match on a first come first serve basis. Only 1 referee is required for U6 and U8.
4. Points awarded for each match are:
 - a. Each match refereed has a maximum value of 6 pts.
 - b. The full amount of points can only be obtained by two teams providing three referees to cover a match.
 - c. If one team decides to provide three referees, that team will receive 3 pts.
 - d. When two teams provide one referee each and are forced to run a "2-Man System" due to a lack of referee's available on standby from the region, each team will receive 3 pts.
 - e. If two teams can only provide one referee each and a third referee volunteers from any team not scheduled for that match, the full "3-Man" referee team **MUST BE USED** and each team will receive 2 pts. This is a great opportunity for those that might be behind on team points to catch up.
 - f. Any match refereed in the non-competitive divisions (U-6 & U-8) by a referee will receive one point towards their team. This is a great opportunity for our Junior Referee's to get some experience.

Tournament Volunteers Needed

We will soon begin planning the annual tournament we host each February. Last year over eighty teams participated at two venues—Hook Park and Mesa Linda Park. We hope to grow even more this year, but in order to do so, we need help.

If you can attend about six one-to-two hour meetings between November and February, and spend the weekend of February 10—11, 2007 working at the tournament, please see either Karen Williams or Robert Olivarez at the Information Tent to volunteer.
