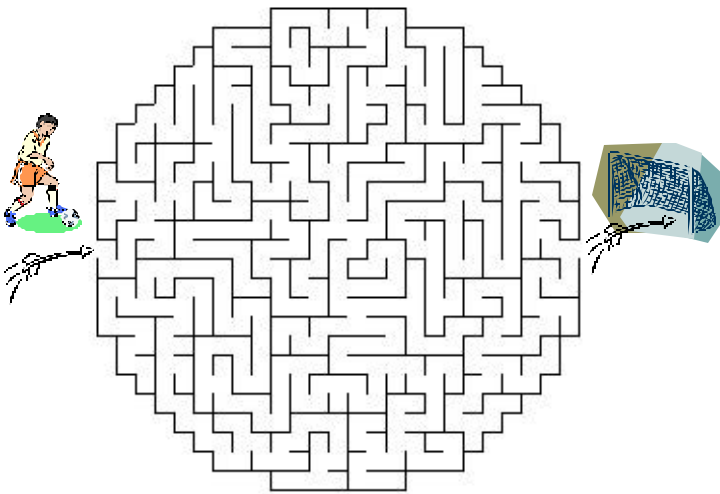

## Team Referee Point Requirements

1. Teams must full fill their referee assignments
2. Teams must meet the minimum point requirement for their division
  - a. U14 Boys and Girls = 36 minimum points required
  - b. U12 Boys and Girls = 36 minimum points required
  - c. U10 Boys and Girls = 39 minimum points required

\*\*Failure to meet criteria one and two will result in forfeit of team's participation in regional playoffs regardless of wins or loss

3. Divisions U10, U12, and U14, if not assigned enough games to meet minimum point requirement for their division, they can sign up for "open" games at least one week in advance. They can also referee any U8 or U6 match on a first come first serve basis. Only 1 referee is required for U6 and U8.

4. Points awarded for each match are:

- a. Assigned matches (U10-U14) = 3 pts per team that meets their assignment
- b. Signing up and referee for "open" games = 3 pts
- c. U8 and U6 is = 1 point per match, maximum of 1 referee

\*\*The only exceptions must be directed to ONLY Greg Stanfill or Robert Olivarez...No other conversations with anyone else will be accepted by the RC for missed assignments and/or not meeting point requirement.

## AYSO OFFERS ONLINE TRAINING

TO GAIN ACCESS TO THE AYSO ONLINE TRAINING SITE: You will need your AYSO ID number to access the courses AND your region must have registered you in either the FS2005 or FS2006 membership year.

If you haven't already done so, you will need to submit a volunteer application to your region. An application must be submitted each year. This can be completed easily online at [www.eayso.org](http://www.eayso.org). When you've entered all the requested information, print out at least two copies of the application, sign and date each one, then submit them to your region. When the region processes your application our system will issue your AYSO I.D. number. The region can provide you the number or you can send an email request to the address below, and we can forward it to you. Please include your region number in any message.

New registration data is uploaded to the training site within 48 hours following activation by the region. As a result you may have to wait a day or two to take the course.
