## Cake Walk on September 26

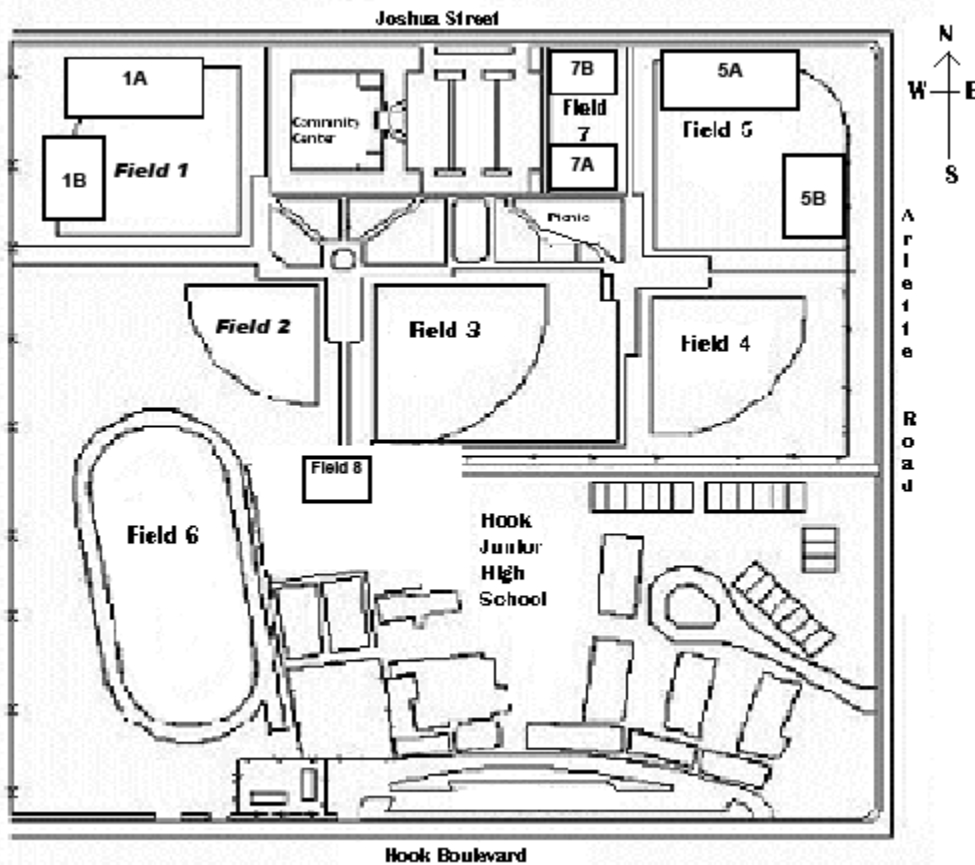
