Parents and Volunteers of AYSO,

For those of you who do not know me, my name is Robert Olivarez and I am the Regional Commissioner for AYSO 665 in Victorville. I would like to take a moment as we are nearing the end of the season to thank all of our volunteers and players for their efforts thus far. It is you both collectively and individually that help ensure our kids have a great AYSO experience by fostering the 6 core philosophies of AYSO.

I would like to also briefly explain the role of the regional board and staff. First of all the region has an executive board which includes the Regional Commissioner, Coach & Referee Administrators, Safety Director, CVPA (Child and Volunteer Protection Advocate), Treasurer, and Registrar. These positions require progressive roles of responsibility in the region prior to being an executive member, must be appointed by the Regional Commissioner, and approved by the executive board.
